The Northern Village of Air Ronge is inviting applications for a full-time, permanent Public Works Lead Hand to join our Municipal operations team.

This position reports to the Public Works Foreman and is responsible to perform preventative and operational maintenance on hydrants, lift stations, roadways, culverts, signage, equipment, and facilities. This position operates various municipal equipment including half-ton trucks, loader, gravel truck, backhoe, skid steer, garbage truck and others as required, may respond to emergency situations and is required to be on call on a rotational basis, including evenings and weekends.

The Public Works Lead Hand is offered a salary range of \$31.24 to \$36.75 per hour, dependent upon experience and qualifications. The Village of Air Ronge offers a competitive benefits package including pension, and professional development opportunities.

#### **REQUIRED EXPERIENCE & QUALIFICATIONS**
